Live demonstrations of cutting-edge satellite navigation applications and a major three-day conference promoting the use of EGNOS and Galileo will be part of the launch of the 2010 European Satellite Navigation Competition.

Galileo Application Days, will feature a first ever over 2,000 M² meter public 'Application Village', where demonstrations and presentations of over 30 innovative uses of satellite navigation technology will occur. Visitors will get a chance to see viable satellite navigation applications developed through the EU's 7th Research Framework Programme, the European Satellite Navigation Competition, the European Space Agency Technology Transfer Programme, and national and regional initiatives, in a lively animated atmosphere.

- Race against Formula1 drivers on a gaming console,
- Detect urban pollution on location,
- See real-time pictures and videos from a flight robot,
- Watch a family keep track of each other in a crowded public space

- Geo-tag photos through mobile EGNOS-enabled devices will be in the city section.

- Experience how new satellite navigation innovations are making our lives safer and more sustainable, our businesses more efficient, and much more.
